Doug Carroll brought the meeting to order at 6:35 pm

The first order of business was to accept the April 2020 Board Meeting minutes as submitted by Kathy Kendall (Secretary). Doug Carroll made the motion to accept. Hector Martinez seconded the motion. There was no further discussion or corrections. The motion passed with all ayes and no abstentions.

Jim Hedderick has an AutoCross tentatively scheduled for June 14th at the Houston Police Academy. He will update any changes as soon as they are available.
